BOARD NOMINATIONS and ELECTION



The results are in! Five candidates have submitted their intent for the Board of Directors for the five vacant positions. Therefore, we will not be holding an election. The officer positions will be decided at an Organizational Meeting on April 20th.

NOISE CONCERNS BETWEEN UNITS



The Association Office has been receiving an increase in the number of complaints over noise between Units, especially from those residents on lower floors regarding Units above them.

We are hoping that by raising awareness, all residents will be more considerate of each other.

NEW MAILBOX INSTALLATIONS CONTINUE



We are continuing with the replacemet of mailboxes in the community. This is being done on a section by section gradual basis for each group of boxes as new keys will need to be issued to all residents. We will also use this opportunity to make sure the Association has the correct key to your Unit on file (as required by the governing documents for emergency purposes).

Residents will receive notice when their section of boxes is being scheduled for replacement and what to bring to the Office to obtain your new key.

Unfortunately, this will result in a temporary disruption of mail delivery for approximately 2-3 days while the work is being completed. Resident's mail will be held at the Post Office or a resident can pick it up at the Post Office.

LET'S TALK TRASH



The Association Office has been receiving concerns lately regarding the trash valet service. Those concerns are being addressed with the vendor. To provide the best possible service, the Association also has contractual obligations with the trash service company that we urge all residents to follow. This will ensure that your trash is properly collected. Here are some reminders:

ALL TRASH SHOULD BE BAGGED IN 13 GALLON BAGS and TIED. LARGER BAGS AND UNTIED BAGS WILL NOT BE COLLECTED.

NO LOOSE ITEMS OR GROCERY BAGS SHOULD BE PLACED IN THE COLLECTION BINS. THE VALET COMPANY WILL NOT REMOVE THESE ITEMS.

ALL BOXES SHOULD BE BROKEN DOWN AND TAKEN DIRECTLY TO THE TRASH COMPACTOR BY THE RESIDENT. THE COLLECTION COMPANY WILL NOT PICK THESE UP.

PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR PATIO/BALCONY IS FREE OF CLUTTER. THE TRASH COLLECTORS MUST HAVE UNOBSTRUCTED ACCESS TO THE BIN.

PLEASE REPORT ANY SERVICE DISRUPTIONS TO THE ASSOCIATION OFFICE SO THEY CAN BE ADDRESS AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

HELP WITH GATE CONGESTION
